In the military complaints process

I would like to add the following to my complaints from yesterday:

The fact that in the Bundeswehr - despite a vaccination rate of 95 percent fully vaccinated - 28 percent of all soldiers were infected within 4.5 months allows the assertion in the BVerwG decision "that the vaccination compared to the now predominant Omicron variant still has a relevant protective effect in terms of reducing infection and transmission." seem absurd. At least that's what the press release from the BVerwG says at <https://www.bverwg.de/pm/2022/44>.

The RKI expert Dr. At the hearing on June 7th, Wichmann said that the planned RKI monthly report on the effectiveness of the vaccinations - which everyone has been waiting for so long after the RKI last published the vaccination numbers on April 28th - would appear next week (!!).

The explosive thing is that there is data on the need for vaccination that shows that the benefits of vaccination for the age group 18-59, i.e. for the age group relevant for the Bundeswehr, are negligible simply because there are hardly any serious ones diseases occur.

The RKI vaccination report gives the 7-day incidence of hospitalizations due to COVID-19 for unvaccinated 18-59 year olds (see Figure 5, page 12). In calendar weeks 16-19 - these are the most recent weekly data - this averaged 0.3 hospitalizations per 100,000 people. Exact numbers can be found here:

That means: For every 1 million unvaccinated (!!) people, there are an average of 3 hospitalizations per week because of COVID-19. This can now be converted to the Bundeswehr:

According to the Bundeswehr, there are 183,427 soldiers (professional soldiers, temporary soldiers and military service volunteers; as of April 30, 2022). And so - if no one in the Bundeswehr were vaccinated (!) - there would be 0.5 hospitalizations per week in the Bundeswehr because of COVID-19, i.e. **one hospitalization every two weeks or two hospitalizations per month.**

With a complete vaccination of the Bundeswehr, one could prevent two hospitalizations per month in the case of a "vaccine" with a (here only theoretically utopian for the purposes of a model calculation assumed utopian) effectiveness of 100% (which is not the case).

That is or would be the true "benefit" of a complete vaccination of the Bundeswehr, even based on the data from the RKI: This prevents two hospitalizations per month.

That in itself is a vanishingly small risk reduction. This extremely small benefit could now be compared with the consequential damage and costs to be reliably expected in the form of vaccination side effects, assuming that the life and health of the soldiers were also "sacred" to all those responsible.

And then it becomes completely clear that this RKI vaccination report alone, if it had appeared earlier and in good time before July 7th, 2022, as announced by the RKI expert Wichmann ("A rogue, who thinks badly about this delay"), is a central point would have clearly refuted the justification for the decision of July 7, 2022 challenged here. Assuming, of course, that the judging Senate is interested in such facts at all.
